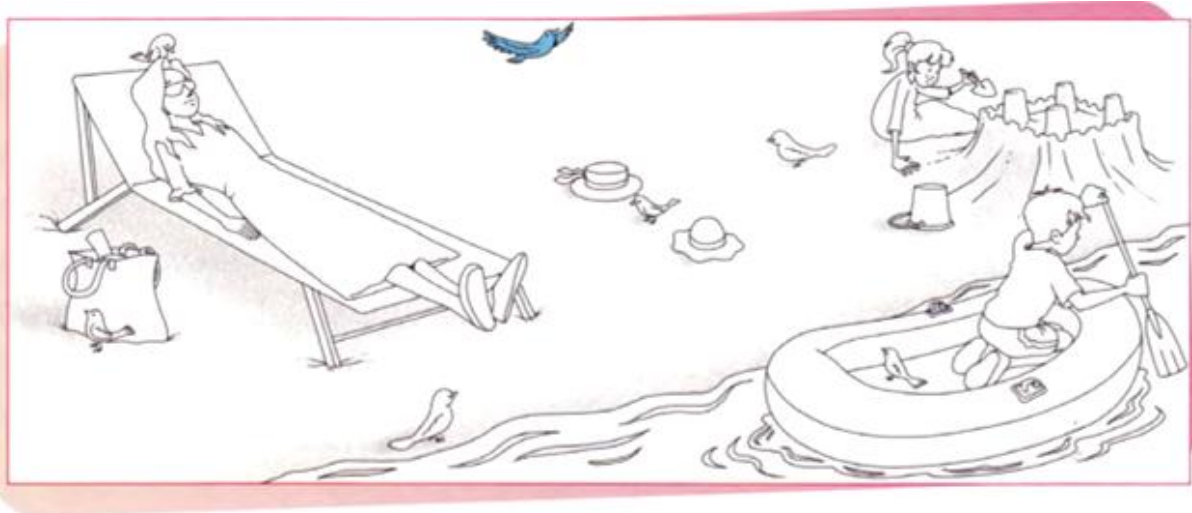

In Russia children usually start school at the age of seven and graduate from school at the age of eighteen.
